

GENERAL CORRESPONDENCE – this was usually being sent to the (Arch)bishop or the Diocesan Secretary, from various parishes and clergy, organisations, and individuals. The correspondence, which is organised in this form well into the twentieth century, begins with the arrival of Archbishop Eyre to the Western District of Scotland in 1869 and continues after he was translated to the restored Archdiocese of Glasgow in 1878.
